


SEPTEMBER 2020

Dear friends,

I hope you are all doing well despite the current situation. We all had a challenging and emotional time, isolated from our beloved ones and living in uncertainty facing an unknown virus. This particular moment was an opportunity to think about changing the relation of the man to the world.

To face this difficult period, a large number of solidarity movements have emerged. Many artists found themselves without work, commission or project. Exhibitions and sales have disappeared. In an attempt to help and support these artists, Matthew Burrows, English painter, founded the #artist-supportpledge international platform on Instagram. The concept is a simple one. Artists post images of their work on Instagram which they are willing to sell for no more than € 200 each (excluding shipping). Every time an artist reaches € 1,000 of sales, they pledge to spend € 200 another artist's work. Touched by the generosity of this initiative, I wanted to take part in this cause by offering a selection of 10 prints at an affordable price (a small percentage of my usual gallery price) via this online platform.








United by light, Yves Ullens & Samuel Levy




EXCLUSIVE INTERVIEW



This collective exhibition focuses on the question of abstraction in the field of contemporary photography. A subject that is at the heart of my own research..
